## **Who can Apply for Scholarship ?**

1. Student must be of Jharkhand State.
2. Student must be either Schedule Tribe (ST) or Schedule Caste (SC) or Backward Class (BC).
3. Students Annual Family Income from all sources should not exceed as per the list given below.
  - (i) Schedule Tribe (ST) or Schedule Caste (SC) Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lacs Fifty thousand only)
  - (ii) Backward Class (BC) Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lac only)

# Post Matric Scholarship for students belonging to the minority community (Central Government)



- **Eligibility** - Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.
- **Distribution** - Muslim, Christian, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992.

# National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST students.



- Eligibility - Scheduled Tribe, Certificate issued by the competent authority
- Certificate to the effect that the total family income from all sources shall not exceed Rs 6.0 lakh per annum in the case of Scholarships

# SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME II – FOR 2500 DIFFERENTLY ABLED STUDENTS

- **Eligibility** - To start with every year 2500 scholarships will be provided to the differently-abled students throughout the country. 30% scholarships will be reserved for girls, which will be transferable to male students in case of non-availability of female candidates.
- The annual income of the beneficiary/parent or guardian of beneficiary should not exceed Rs. 3.00 lakh from all sources. However, preference shall be given to economically weaker students.

# CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (CSSS) – Govt of India



- **Eligibility conditions:**

1. Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant
  2. stream from a particular Board of Examination in Class XII
  3. Pursuing regular course
  4. Having family income of less than Rs.6 lakh per annum
  5. Not receiving any other scholarship
- The rate of scholarship is Rs. 10000/- per annum at Graduation level for first three years
  - of College and University courses and Rs. 20000/- per annum at Post-Graduation level.
  - Students pursuing professional courses are paid Rs. 20,000/- per annum in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year.

# selection of students for award of different scholarship under "Medhabruti" Scheme for Students of Odisha – Govt of Odisha



- Eligibility

1. Qualifying marks in last examination (in aggregate) --- 60% of + 3 Final Result for both boys and girls.
2. Quantum (No. of students) per year --- 1500
3. Period of scholarship ( in years) --- 2 years
4. Amount of scholarship per year (10 months in a year @ Rs. 1000/-) --- Rs.10000/-
5. Annual income ceiling of parents must not exceed Rs. 6.00 lakhs.
6. Selection of students for this category of scholarship shall be made through descending order of merit.
7. M.Phil and Ph.D., students are not eligible under PG merit.
