CORRIGENDUM

Following amendment is hereby made in Para 2 of Order No. CUJ/VC Sectt./2016/01/30/c Dated: 28th Mar 2016 below "The circumstances in which the order of suspension was made as follows:-"

For:

Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Centre of English Language was assigned the duties to organize 140th Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbai Patel in the University on 17-19 March 2016. Hon'ble Governor, State of Jharkhand had consented to become the chief guest of the celebrations on 19th March 2016. In the meantime, Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Centre of English Language invited Prof. N.M. Panini from JNU as Guest of Honour for the said celebrations on 19th March 2016 without prior permission from the office of the Vice Chancellor. Prof. Panini is considered as mentor of the group of students of JNU, who were involved in anti-national activities in JNU campus recently. As such, the invitation to Prof. Panini by Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, without examining his credentials, led to wide spread criticism from different quarters of the society as a result of which not only the image of the University was tarnished as well as the reputation of the Vice Chancellor was put on stake. The decision of Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Center of English Language, regarding sharing the dais by Hon'ble Governor, State of Jharkhand with a person of disputed integrity (Prof. Panini) ultimately led to cancellation of visit of Hon'ble Governor, State of Jharkhand in the University campus on 19th March 2016.

The above said act of Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Centre of English Language is misconduct under Section 3(1) of CCS(Conduct) Rules 1964 and hence this decision.

expected to become the chief guest of the celebrations on 19th March 2016 which was verbally informed by Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji in a meeting held on 16.03.2016. In the meantime, Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Centre of English Language invited Prof. N.M. Panini from JNU as Guest of Honor for the said celebrations on 19th March 2016 without written permission from the office of the Vice Chancellor. It has been alleged that Prof. Panini is considered as mentor of the group of students of JNU, who were involved in anti-national activities in JNU campus recently. As such, the invitation to Prof. Panini by Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, without examining his credentials, led to wide spread criticism from different quarters of the society as a result of which not only the image of the University was tarnished but the reputation of the Vice Chancellor was also put on stake. Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Centre of English Language, should not have proposed sharing the dais by Hon'ble Governor, State of Jharkhand with a person of disputed integrity (Prof. Panini). The people believe that due to this the visit of Hon'ble Governor, State of Jharkhand in the University campus on 19th March, 2016 could not be confirmed.

The above said act of Dr. Shreya Bhattacharji, Associate Professor, Centre of English Language is misconduct under Section 3(1) of CCS(Conduct) Rules 1964 and hence this decision.
