Shri Anant Kumar Singh, JS, MHRD and the Visitor nominee, could not attend the meeting due to his prior engagement.

At the outset, the Vice Chancellor extended a warm welcome to all and introduced the members and Dr. J.N. Nayak, Controller of Examinations as i/c of Finance Officer. He informed the members that the term of the First Finance Committee was for three years and over on 25th February, 2013. The Vice Chancellor thanked all the members for sparing their valuable time to be in the Central University of Jharkhand to attend the first meeting of the Second Finance Committee and 9th meeting of the Finance Committee of the University.

The Chairman stated that the Central University of Jharkhand was established by an Act of Parliament in 2009 with many other Central Universities and came into existence from 1st March, 2009 with the joining of the first Vice Chancellor of the University. The classes for the first academic session were started in August, 2009 with four Five-year Integrated Courses and at present, 20 Centres of studies under 09 Schools are in operation at its Brambe Campus, which is provided by the Govt. of Jharkhand as a temporary Campus.

Apprising the house about the development/progress made by the University, the Vice Chancellor informed that out of 500 acres earmarked for the University; the Govt. of Jharkhand has already handed over only 319.28 acres of land to the University at Mouza Cheri-Manatu, Kanke Block, Ranchi in January, 2012. The Committee visited the permanent Campus at Mouza Cheri-Manatu, Kanke Block, Ranchi in the morning and physically took stock of the construction works. The Committee unanimously appreciated the efforts of the Vice Chancellor for the progress of the construction work at permanent Campus within a short period of time.
