CONCENSUS

Sub: Appropriate specification of Integrated M. Tech degree in Water Engineering & Management.

A meeting of the students of different batches of Integrated M. Tech in Water Engineering & Management held with Hon'ble Vice Chancellor on 22nd April, 2016 in reference to above mentioned subject. The students raised the issue regarding the award of dual degree i.e. B. Tech in Civil Engineering as well as in M. Tech in Water Engineering & Management after completion of five years.

According to the students, despite having Civil Engineering as their core subject, they are unable to fill-up/apply for the employments (Graduation level) because of not having B. Tech in Civil Engineering. According to them, their scope will increase manifold if the same will be mentioned on the degree. The course structure designed is fully based on the Civil Engineering syllabus with specialization in Water Engineering and Management but at the time of interview they are asked about the core subject again and again so they demanded the administration to take an urgent step so that their identity in employment sector and in the society could be asserted.

The issues were discussed in details in presence of Administrative Staff. The student were informed that in terms of UGC Notification no. 27 dated 5th July, 2014, it is not possible for the university to award them the dual degree of B. Tech & M. Tech, however it has been agreed that since the integrated course has been designed by combining the two degrees i.e. B. Tech in Civil Engineering and M. Tech in Water Engineering & Management, thus the case will be taken up with UGC to issue a clarificatory notification that the degree of integrated M. Tech in Water Engineering & Management incorporates B. Tech in Civil Engineering and hence they are eligible for all the employments which require the educational qualification of B. Tech in Civil Engineering. So it was decided that the deemed incorporated degree of B. Tech in Civil Engineering shall be mentioned along with M. Tech in Water Engineering &

Management in final degree of students after completion of Five year integrated programme, if UGC agrees for the same.

The Vice Chancellor further assured that he will personally look into the matter and take up the issue with MHRD/UGC for resolution for Grievances of students at the earliest.
