The abstract should not exceed 300 words, and the full paper, including tables, diagrams, illustrations, references, etc., should be approximately between 3500-5000 words. Manuscripts must be typed in MS Word, using Times New Roman font with a font size of 12 (papers in Hindi should be in Kruti Dev 010). References should be arranged alphabetically and placed at the end of the text in the APA format.
