ABOUT CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF JHARKHAND (CUJ)

The Central University of Jharkhand was established through the Central University Act, 2009. The University started with a vision to specifically focus on relevant present age educational drives with an emphasis on research in cutting edge technologies. It offers Under Graduate, Post Graduate and Ph.D. programmes across 24 departments. These departments are grouped into various schools such as School of Management Science, Mass Communication, Language, Natural Sciences, Engineering & Technology, Education, Social Science & Humanities. The University is open to new ideas in course curricula and research proposals, collaboration, interaction and capacity building programmes. Being located in Jharkhand, the study of culture is the thrust area of the University as manifested in Centre for Indigenous Culture Studies, Centre for Tribal & Customary Law, Centre for Tribal Folklore, Language & Literature and Music & Performing Arts. The CUJ Faculty have been awarded national and international fellowships, project funding and recognition and are constantly contributing to the Government, Public and Private Sector organisations through teaching and consulting. The students have also won accolades in national level academics and extramural activities. The Central University of Jharkhand has been a pioneer in adopting NEP-2020.

Situated in the capital of Jharkhand – Ranchi, the university is spread across an area of 550 acres between the scenic mountains of the Chhota Nagpur region.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND FINANCIAL STUDIES (DCFS)

The Department of Commerce and Financial Studies (DCFS) was formally set up as a separate department in the year 2019. The department is a part of the School of Management Sciences of the University. Currently the department offers 2 years post-graduate programme - Masters in Commerce (M.Com) and the Doctoral Programme (Ph. D.). It aims to offer other UG/PG courses in the field of commerce and financial management education. At present, the department has 4 permanent faculty members (<u>https://cuj.ac.in/dcfs/all-profiles.php#</u>). There are 18 full time research scholars in the department. The faculty members and scholars have regularly contributed their research work in Scopus/ UGC-CARE Journals and conferences organized by institutions of repute such as IIM, Jamia, Delhi University, etc. During last three years faculties and scholars of DCFS have published more than 26 papers in Scopus/ UGC-CARE Journals and book chapters. The department aims to redefine commerce education in the country by offering quality education and research in the Commerce discipline. The courses offered aim to provide extreme and rigorous base for teaching, research and allied business administration.

The department has regularly organised programs for the benefit of faculties, scholars and students. Some of the recent programs like ICSSR sponsored two days national seminar, a week-long research methodology program were very well received by the academia.

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

The workshop is primarily aimed at Doctoral Students – who are actively pursuing research. Considering that the candidates might be at different stages of their respective research work, the stipulated 30 sessions across 10 days have been bifurcated into two weeks. The first week shall serve as orientation to the different facets and fundamentals of research methodology. The second week shall provide a hands-on experience to statistical tools such as Factor Analysis, Structural Equation Modelling, Panel Data and Time Series Analysis, Cluster and Discriminant Analysis, etc. using STATA, SPSS and R. e-library resources and Paper Clinics are opportunities where the participants can enhance the quality of their working papers and know about the opportunities for publishing. The participants shall be provided an exposure to field study at JHARCRAFT (Jharkhand Silk Textile & Handicraft Development Corporation Ltd.) manufacturing centre, near Ranchi. Where they will observe and interact with artisans and understand how this organization is contributing to their livelihoods.

RESOURCE PERSONS

Sessions in the workshop will be taken by faculties from institutions like IIM, IIT, NIT and other Central Universities.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Research scholars currently pursuing their M.Phil./Ph.D./PDF in social science (Commerce, Management, Economics etc.) disciplines from recognized Universities/Institutes across India are eligible to apply.

INTAKE

A maximum of 30 participants shall be shortlisted (10 from local, 10 from within the state and 10 from rest of India).

- 3. Selected participants will have to bring their laptops.
