Subject: Inviting Online Application Forms for the Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG) - 2024] for Admission to Undergraduate Programmes into Central Universities and Other Participating Universities / Institutions / Organizations / Autonomous Colleges – reg.

The National Testing Agency has been mandated by the Ministry of Education and UGC to conduct the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into Undergraduate Programmes in Central Universities under the Ministry of Education, and other participating Universities / Institutions / Organizations / Autonomous Colleges.

The CUET (UG) provides a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country.

For the Academic Session 2024-25, CUET (UG) – 2024 will be conducted in the Hybrid mode (Computer-Based Test (CBT) / Pen & Paper) as per the details given below:

The CUET (UG) - 2024 will be conducted in 13 languages i.e. English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.

The CUET (UG) - 2024 is being offered in 380 cities including 26 cities outside India (Annexure 2).

For Papers, Scheme, Timing, eligibility, and other information, candidates are requested to please check the Information Bulletin of CUET (UG) – 2024 available on the website: https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-UG/ For CUET (UG) – 2024, the following is the scheme of examination:

Subjects/ Tests (61)	Questions to be Attempted
There are 33 languages and 27 subjects. A candidate may choose any subject/language as desired by the applicable University/ Organization.	40 questions to be attempted out of 50 in each language
General Test: For any such undergraduate programme / programmes being offered by Universities where a General Test is being used for admission.	50 Questions to be attempted out of 60

Note:

- From the above subjects/languages, the candidate can choose a maximum of 06 (six) subjects from all three Sections.
- 2. 40 out of 50 questions for all test papers and 50 out of 60 for the General Test (An overall choice of 10 questions will be provided for all 61 subjects).
- 3. It is advisable for candidates to select at least one language and the General Test.
- 4. Duration for all test papers would be 45 minutes except for Mathematics/Applied Mathematics, Accountancy, Physics, Chemistry, Economics, Computer Science/Informatics Practices, and General Tests which would be 60 minutes.
- The examination will be conducted on multiple days in two or three shifts, depending on the number of Candidates and Subject choices.

Important Instructions:

- Candidates can apply for CUET (UG) 2024 through the "Online" mode only on the website https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-UG/ The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- ii. Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. Under no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.
- iii. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-UG/ Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- iv. Candidates must ensure that the e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardians' only as all information/communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address or SMS on the registered Mobile Number only.
