The Central University of Jharkhand (CUJ) came into existence on March 01, 2009 with a vision **"to develop enlightened citizenship of a knowledge society for peace and prosperity of individuals, nation and the world, through promotion of innovation, creative endeavours, and scholarly inquiry."** The Central University of Jharkhand is the only Central University in the state of Jharkhand. The University is offering 21 Integrated Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) programs under the National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020), 12 Postgraduate and 20 Doctoral programs in the academic session 2024-25.

The city of Ranchi is located at 23.23 N latitude and 85.23 E longitude at a height of 2140 feet above sea level. The campus of the University is located at Cheri-Manatu, Ranchi which is about 18 kilometers from Ranchi Railway Station and about 30 kilometers from Birsa Munda Airport, Ranchi. The campus is located on Ranchi ring road near ITBP campus. The campus is in rapid expansion mode under the first phase of development and includes hostels, library, academic and administrative buildings.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

The Department of Chemistry was established in 2010 with an objective to provide quality education in advanced areas of Chemical Sciences and to produce excellent scientific manpower to meet the needs of Universities/Institutes, research institutes and industries. The vision of the Department aligns with the University and emphasizes that learning process should be reflected in achievements and growth of the students as well as faculty members. The department is supported by DST-FIST. It has the thrust to grow as an excellent teaching and research department in the country and across the globe. The department has adopted National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020) courses and offers an integrated 5-years (B.Sc. and M.Sc.) program. The department encourages students to take MOOC courses from the "SWAYAM" portal to improve their subject understanding. The department is also offering Ph.D. program in areas of organic, inorganic, physical, bioinorganic, analytical, environmental, renewable energy and material chemistry. Students in the department are monitored and evaluated through sessional tests, seminars, assignments, mid and end-semester examinations.

During the last thirteen years, the department has received several research projects from different funding agencies like DST, DBT and UGC. The department has produced good number of research scholars and the faculty members have published in high impact reputed national and international journals, book chapters and edited books. 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SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY ENGINEERING

The Department of Energy Engineering (DEE), earlier known as Centre for Energy Engineering, came into existence in July 2011 under the School of Engineering and Technology. The department is committed to uphold the vision and mission of the University for the overall development of the region, and the country by emphasizing on the needs of renewable energy technologies and their applications for the common masses. The department is currently running a five-year integrated B.Tech.-M.Tech. program, as well as Ph.D. program in Energy Engineering under a development and innovation-friendly environment for nurturing and promoting novel ideas with intensive interaction and co-operations at local, regional, national and international levels. The establishment of the Centre of Excellence in Green and Efficient Energy Technology with funding under the FAST scheme of the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India is a step in that direction. The department has already signed/taken initiative to sign MoU with a few specialized national/international level organizations/institutions working in the field of energy.

Students interested in joining the energy department have opportunities in a variety of occupational areas. After earning their bachelor's and master's degrees, they can pursue higher education and work as an assistant professor in educational institutions in both public and private sectors. They can also work as research scientists. Many students consider career in Non-governmental Organizations. Students who pursue competitive tests may become civil employees or community servants. Most and multiple number of our M. Tech. students are well placed in ministry, national and multinational companies/organizations related to renewable energy such as Ministry of New and Renewable Energy(MNRE), companies like Tata Power, Vikram Solar, Sterling and Wilson Solar Ltd, Mitsui Chemicals India, Infraline Energy, GSES, Ernst & Young, Arcadis, First Green, EKI Energy etc. ; and organizations like ISTP John Hopkins University USA, Centre for Environment and Energy Development (CEED) New Delhi, Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) New Delhi; Solar Energy Research Centre (SERC), University of Santiago, Chile; iFOREST, etc. A good number of students are doing PhD in India (IISc, IITs, and NITs) and abroad (Germany, Italy, Spain, Portugal). Two startups are also registered by our students.

DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL ENGINEERING

The Department of Civil Engineering came into existence in year 2022 after the merger of Department of Water Engineering and Management (established in 2010 as the Centre for Water Engineering and Management) and the Department of Transport Science and Technology (established in 2019).



Currently the Department of Civil Engineering is offering 5 years Integrated UG-PG programs in line with NEP 2020 and Ph.D. program in Water Resources Engineering/Transportation Engineering.

PROGRAMS OF STUDY OFFERED FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25:

- Integrated B. Tech. and M. Tech. in Civil and Engineering
- Ph.D. in Civil Engineering

FACILITIES:

The department intends to impart quality education and skilled training for a better understanding of the complexity of water resources development and management, and transportation engineering issues at regional, national and global levels. Students are trained to acquire knowledge and skills in tools and techniques to come up with viable and sustainable solutions within the framework of the integrated water resources management at the river basin scale. The department is looking into multi-disciplinary issues in the planning, design, implementation, operation and maintenance of irrigation projects and soil and water conservation programs. Transportation Engineering includes urban transport and transportation economics etc. The department is having the following common facilities for the students: Digital Classrooms with a sitting capacity of 60 each; Laboratories with instrumentations; Common digital platform for sharing official and academic information, seminar hall and common reading room; Computational Laboratory facilities with high-end Workstations, Desktops and computational softwares; Uninterrupted internet with Wi-Fi; Training and Placement and Career Guidance. The department has the following common Laboratories facilities for the students like Structural and M.O.S Lab, Building Material Lab, Concrete Lab, Surveying Lab, Geology Lab, Hydraulics & W.R.E. Lab, Soil Mechanics Lab, Environmental Engineering Laboratory, Transportations Lab, Irrigation and Drainage Lab, Geotechnical Lab and Fluid Mechanics Lab.

After completion of the Integrated M. The Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering (formerly known as Department of Nanoscience and Technology) was established in 2010 with the purpose of creating an exciting, diverse, collaborative and supportive ambience that advances materials engineering by developing fundamental understanding, adopting frontier technologies, providing education and enabling technological innovations. The Department currently offers Integrated (B.Tech.-M.Tech.) and Ph.D. programs. The department attempts to offer an inexorable curriculum added with cutting edge knowledge driven activities for both academic and professional excellence for its students. The integrated (B. Tech.-M. Tech.) program comprises various aspects of materials including their mechanical behavior, physical metallurgy, thermodynamics, kinetics etc. The focus of the integrated program is to impart excellent knowledge and training to the students who would be able to join different global metallurgical industries or research organizations as qualified engineers, researchers and scientists. The Ph. D. program is designed to train students for nurturing innovation in the domain of materials engineering to meet the cutting-edge technological requirements.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR INTEGRATED (UG-PG) AND POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMS (Except Integrated B.Tech.-M.Tech. Programs)

Admission in Integrated UG-PG and PG programs (Except Integrated B.Tech.-M.Tech. Programs) involves the following three stages:

- 1. Submission of application form for Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission in appropriate course of Integrated or PG programs by selecting Central University of Jharkhand as desired University of choice and taking entrance test wherever applicable.
- 2. Registration followed by counselling at Central University of Jharkhand.
- 3. Submission of fees and required documents for completing the admission process.
- Note: Candidates are advised to take note that any change made in the admission procedure, documents required, seat matrix, etc. will be displayed on the University website and/or admission portal, and such notifications shall be deemed to be applicable for the admission process.

A. APPLICATION FORM AND ENTRANCE TEST:

Admission in Integrated (UG-PG) and Postgraduate programs (except for Integrated B.Tech.-M.Tech.) for academic session 2024-25 at Central University of Jharkhand (CUJ) will be based on the score of CUET-2024 conducted by National Testing Agency (NTA). The candidates desirous to take admission in CUJ need to appear in CUET UG- 2024 or CUET PG-2024 as applicable. The score/marks of CUET shall be used for determining merit of candidates for admission against the number of seats announced by university for individual program under each category.

B. REGISTRATION AND COUNSELLING:

- 1. Prospective candidates opting for admission in programs offered by Central University of Jharkhand for the Academic Year 2024-25, must have valid score (above cut-off, if applicable) in the relevant test papers mapped for the program.
- 2. Eligibility criteria as specified for each program, will be strictly followed and will not be relaxed under any circumstance. Candidates must fulfill all the eligibility requirements as prescribed in each program at the time of online registration for admission at CUJ. The detailed process and link for online registration is available on university website.
- 3. Candidates satisfying the eligibility conditions and desirous to take admission, must participate in online registration process by paying non-refundable registration/counselling fee notified on the University website.
- 4. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure and confirm their eligibility at their end for admission at CUJ as per the admission notification details available on the University's website.
- 5. Registration fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstance. The fee will be valid for registration up to three programs by each candidate.
- 6. Candidates are advised to complete the registration process within the date notified on website. The list of documents required during registration process is available at http://cuj.ac.in/ admission2024.php.
- 7. Candidates who fail to register will not be considered for subsequent stages of counselling and admission process.

- 8. Candidate(s) must ensure that mobile no. and e-mail ID provided by him/her are valid and functional during counselling/admission period. The mobile no. and e-mail ID must be his/her own or of close family members/guardians.
- 9. Candidates are advised to pay the fee from their own bank account or the bank account of close family member/guardian, and it should not be from the account of others or unknown person because the refund of fee will be remitted in the same account, if any, arising out of cancellation or otherwise. It is advised to keep a copy of fee receipt either in digital or print form for future reference, if required.
- 10. Candidates are required to provide correct information in the registration/application form and verify the same before confirming the application and making payment of registration/application fees.
- 11. After confirming the data filled in application form, no changes will be allowed. Any request for alteration in application will not be considered.
- 12. CUJ follows reservations under all categories as per Government of India and University Grants Commission Regulations. Kindly refer to reservation rules and certificate formats for admission placed on the University website.
- 13. Seat allocation is an automatic process based on merit, data provided and documents submitted by the candidate, after duly following the reservation rules.

C. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. List of shortlisted candidates shall be displayed on the University website.
- 2. Candidates are required to periodically check the University website to get the latest status of shortlisting and further steps of the admission process, if any.
- 3. Category-wise merit list shall be prepared on the basis of aggregate normalized scores or percentile obtained by the candidates in the respective paper(s) of CUET-2024 after declaration of result by NTA.
- 4. Selection status along with merit list and waiting list will be displayed on the University website.
- 5. Candidates whose name appear in the merit list, will have to report physically to the University on the specified date to participate in the admission process, failing which their candidature shall not be considered for next step.
- 6. After considering candidates from the merit list in Unreserved category, a separate category wise Merit List highlighting the number of seats reserved for each category as per University Grant Commission regulations/ Government of India will also be prepared. All reservation rules will be applied to prepare the final merit list and seat allotment.
- 7. Rule in case of 'tie' (where two or more candidates' merit score is same even in decimals) belonging to same/any category: If two or more candidates' merit score are 'tied' in final combined merit list then preference shall be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in 'qualifying examination' amongst the two. If this also goes tie, then, elder in 'age' among those two, will be considered. If 'age' also goes tie, then the candidate having higher HSC/SSC marks among those will be considered for admission as per combined merit list.
- 8. Choice or preferences of program/category indicated in the registration/application form by the candidate at the time of filling online registration/application form cannot be changed at any point after submission of the registration/application form. Any request for change or modification in this regard shall not be entertained or responded to.

- 9. Candidates who get selected in the higher preference; their names will not be listed in the lower preference merit list.
- 10. Candidates who get selected in the program of their higher preference will not be on wait-lists for any other program mentioned in their lower preferences.
- 11. Wait List of each program will be prepared by following the same rules as applicable for preparation of merit list.
- 12. If candidates get selected in lower (second or third) preference in the merit list, their name will be shown in the waiting list of higher preference (first or second), if they qualify so with their aggregate normalized score for the program concerned.
- 13. Once moved to higher preference upon activation of waiting list, the candidate will vacate the seat in the lower preference and no request for considering their seat in the lower preference will be entertained.
- 14. Once an offer of admission is made, the candidate(s) is/are required to complete the offline admission process including payment of admission fee on the same day or within the scheduled date(s) for that particular round of counselling/admission/allotment. The payment of admission fee shall be collected online through their registration login portal. The candidate must submit the copy of fee payment receipt to confirm their candidateship for that program. On failure to complete the admission process including payment of fee within the scheduled date, the offer of admission shall be cancelled and the seat will be automatically allotted to the next candidate in merit.
- 15. The candidates must bring all original documents and three sets of photo copy of the same for verification.
- 16. If the candidates whose qualifying examination (10+2 or equivalent/graduation or equivalent) is not recognized by GoI/UGC/CUJ and if the same is found at any point of time during the admission process, the application/admission will be rejected.
- 17. Canvassing or influencing for admission at CUJ through any means will lead to rejection of application / disqualification of candidateship.
- 18. Candidates selected for admission should submit original migration certificate from the University / Institution last attended at the time of registration for admission.
- 19. Candidates who are unable to submit migration certificate at the time of admission, shall give undertaking in the prescribed proforma to submit the same on or before the stipulated time period, failing which CUJ reserves the right to cancel their admission.
- 20. Candidates currently employed and selected for admission to any full-time program of study at CUJ are required to produce leaves sanction/ relieving order from their employer at the time of admission, failing which the offer of admission shall stand withdrawn/ forfeited.
- 21. CUJ reserves the right to get any student medically examined and admission of such candidate will be subject to fitness certification from the University medical officer or any other medical officer working in Government hospital.
- 22. If any discrepancy or mis-match found in the details provided in application form, documents uploaded and documents submitted, the University has the right to cancel the admission.
- 23. Since hostel facility is limited, allocation of hostel will be as per CUJ rules. Hostel allotment notice shall be notified separately by the University.

- 24. Admission will be cancelled/suspended at any stage in case of following cases:
 - candidate does not fulfil the eligibility requirements,
 - candidate has used fraudulent means to secure admission,
 - candidate has made false or incorrect information in the application form.

Any complaint/grievance/dispute relating to admission must be filed within one month from the date of closing of admissions. All documents relating to admission of all the candidates, selected or non-selected, will be discarded after this date. Hence, the University will not be in a position to entertain any such complaint/grievance/dispute beyond this date. No refund will be made in case of duplication of application forms and deletion of application after submission and payment of application fees.

- 25. Any refund or fee entitled to be refunded, shall be remitted after completion of admission process as per fee refund rule of the University or UGC, whichever is applicable. The amount will be refund to the bank details provided at the time of registration.
- 26. In case of withdrawal of admission by any admitted student, refund of fees will be as per the following schedule:

- * The above mentioned refund modalities may be changed/modified/regulated as per UGC/Government guideline, if any. All course fees excluding caution deposit. Caution deposit will be returned in full at any point in time.
 - a. In case of (1) in the table above, a processing charge of not more than 5 % of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 2000/- shall be deducted.
 - b. In normal circumstances the refund will be completed within three months from the closing date of all admission.
 - c. In any circumstance, if admission will take place after commencement of class, only caution money will be refunded to those students if opting cancellation/withdrawal of admission.
 - d. Students/candidates are advised to carefully preserve receipts of payments and deposits for any future reference.
- 27. If there is any change in the admission process/eligibility criteria, etc. of either as a whole or program wise, the same shall be notified separately. Candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly for latest details and updates.
ADMISSION IN INTEGRATED B.TECH.-M.TECH. PROGRAMS

For admission in Integrated B.Tech.-M.Tech. programs in CUJ, prospective students must appear in Joint Entrance Examination (main) (JEE-Main) being conducted by NTA.

Score of JEE (main) will be used for seat allocation, merit preparation and admission for academic year 2024-25 through Central Seat Allocation Board (CSAB-2024).

The University however reserves the right to amend, without any notice, any provisions stated in the admission procedure of CSAB.

ADMISSION RESERVATION POLICY

1. Reservation and Merit List Preparation:

Merit list for unreserved category (UR) seats will comprise all applicants in order of merit. It will include SC / ST / OBC-NCL / EWS applicants, irrespective of their category, if they meet the eligibility criteria of merit for UR category. No applicant will be excluded from the UR category merit list just because the applicant belongs to or has applied under SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS category.

Admission to UR category seats will be strictly in order of merit without excluding SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS applicants. Applicants seeking admission under SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS category will have to produce valid certificate in their own name issued by the competent authority. Please check the latest approved norms of eligibility for reservation at: https://www.ugc.ac.in

2. Reservation Categories for Admission in Central University of Jharkhand:

- (i) Other Backward Classes (OBC-Non-Creamy Layers): 27% of the total seats of a program
- (ii) Scheduled Castes (SC): 15% of the total seats of a program
- (iii) Scheduled Tribes (ST): 7.5% of the total seats of a program
- (iv) Economically Weaker Section (EWS): 10% of the total seats of a program
- (v) Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD): 5% (Horizontal)

3. Competent Authorities to Issue Certificate:

The following authorities are competent to issue requisite SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS certificate:

- District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector, Deputy Commissioner
- Additional Deputy Commissioner
- 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate
- Sub-Divisional Magistrate
- Taluka Magistrate

- Executive Magistrate
- Extra Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate)
- Chief Presidency Magistrate
- Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate
- Presidency Magistrate
- Tehsildar

• Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the Applicant and/or his/her family normally resides

Applicants claiming reservation benefit under SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS categories should submit valid certificate issued by any of the above listed authorities in the Government of India (GOI) prescribed format. Any modification in reservation rules by the Government of India shall be applicable mutatis-mutandis. Any request for extension of date for providing category certificate (SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS) shall NOT be entertained.

4. Reservation for applicants claiming to be under GEN-EWS category:

- (i) The Govt. of India vide MHRD OM No. F. No.: 12-4/2019-U1 dated 17th January 2019 and MSJE OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019 for enabling the provision of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes (SC), the Scheduled Tribes (ST) and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), has decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutes subject to a maximum of ten percent (10%) of total seats in each program. For availing this reservation, such applicants need to produce valid certificate from the authorized competent authority. For further details applicants can visit: https://dopt.gov.in/ sites/default/files/ewsf28fT.PDF
- (ii) GEN-EWS certificate (as per Annexure-IA) needs to be uploaded during online registration for admission at Central University of Jharkhand which must be issued on or after 1st April 2024 in consonance with the latest guidelines of the Government of India. If any GEN-EWS candidate fails to submit the GEN-EWS certificate issued on or after 1st April 2024 at the time of online registration, the candidate has to upload a declaration [Declaration in Lieu of Gen-EWS Certificate at Annexure-IB] or the acknowledgement slip of the Gen-EWS Certificate application applied to the office of the competent authority to that effect (Reference: No.F.No.20013/01/2018-BC-II). Certificate issued by authorized official before 1st April 2024 shall not be entertained.
- (iii) In case of non-production of certificate on the day of counselling, the applicant shall be treated under unreserved category (UR) and the next applicant in the merit list, with valid certificate, will be considered for admission in this category.

5. Reservation for applicants claiming to be under OBC-NCL category:

- (i) Twenty seven percent (27%) seats shall be reserved for Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy layer), Central list applicants.
- (ii) OBC-NCL certificate (as per Annexure-IIA) needs to be uploaded during online registration for admission at Central University of Jharkhand which must be issued in consonance with the latest guidelines of Government of India. If any OBC-NCL candidate fails to upload the certificate issued on or after 1st April 2024 at the time of online registration, the candidate has to upload a declaration [Declaration in Lieu of OBC-NCL Certificate as per Annexure-IIB] or the acknowledgement slip of the OBC-NCL Certificate application applied to the office of the competent authority to that effect.

Applicants are advised to visit: http://www.ncbc.nic.in for latest guidelines and updates on the Central List of state-wise OBCs. Certificate issued by non-competent authority or issued before the above mentioned date shall not be accepted.

- (iii) At the time of offering admission to an OBC applicant, the admission office of the University will ensure that the caste is included in the Central List of OBCs notified by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on the recommendations of the National Commission for Backward Classes available at the website http://ncbc.nic.in/backward classes/index.html).The certificate must also mention the non-creamy layer status of the applicant as per DOPT Office Memorandum No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 15.11.1993.
- (iv) In case of non-production of caste certificate on the day of counselling, the applicant shall be treated under unreserved category (UR) and the next applicant in merit list, with valid caste certificate, shall be considered for admission under the OBC category.

6. Reservation for applicants claiming to be under SC or ST category:

- (i) 22.5% of the total numbers of seats is reserved for applicants belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe [15% for Scheduled Caste (SC) and 7.5% for Scheduled Tribes (ST)]. Seats reserved for SC/ST shall be filled by the SC/ST applicants only. However, in case of non-availability of eligible applicants, the reserved seats may be interchanged between SC/ST.
- (ii) The SC/ST applicants, in order to claim reservation benefit need to upload certificate (as per Annexure-III), in accordance with the latest guidelines of the Government of India, during online registration. Certificate issued only by authorized officials shall be considered. If any SC/ST applicant fails to upload certificate at the time of online registration, he/she will have to upload a declaration [Declaration in Lieu of SC/ST Certificate as per Annexure-IIIB] or the acknowledgement slip of the SC/ST certificate application applied to the office of the competent authority to that effect. Applicants are advised to visit: https://ncst.nic.in and http://ncsc.nic.in for latest guidelines and updates in this regard.
- (iii) In case of non-production of valid certificate on the day of counselling, the applicant shall be treated in unreserved category and the next applicant in merit list with valid certificate, shall be considered for admission under that particular category.

7. Reservation for Applicants with Benchmark Disability Differently Abled (V.I. / O.H. / H.I.)

- (i) As per Govt. of India norms, five percent (5%) horizontal reservation is provisioned for persons with benchmark disabilities in central educational institutions. For availing this reservation, such applicants need to produce medical certificate from the authorized medical officer. Such applicants will get horizontal entry in the respective category seats, if applicable.
- (ii) Special care must be taken by applicants that their certificate bears their photograph and the disability percentage should not be less than 40 %.
- (iii) In case of non-production of certificate, as per the above-mentioned parameters on the date of counselling, the applicant shall be treated as any other regular applicant and the next applicant in the merit list, with valid disability certificate, shall be considered for admission under PwBD category.
- (iv) Any request for extension of date for providing PwBD certificate shall not be entertained under any circumstance.

SUPERNUMERARY SEATS

1. Sports Quota Applicants:

- (i) Provision of supernumerary seats under sports quota is only for those candidates who have actively participated at the university/state/national/international level sports activities recognized by Ministry of Youth Affairs, Govt. of India or as mentioned below at Sl. No. (v).
- (ii) Five percent (5%) of total intake in each program (only UG & PG) shall be filled by candidates belonging to the sports quota. The admission under this category shall be made in accordance with the guidelines issued by the University from time to time.
- (iii) Sports certificate of invitational/memorial/open/prize money league/ranking competitions will not be considered.
- (iv) Merit/participation sports certificate of preceding three years, i.e., from 1st July 2021 to 30th June 2024 will only be considered for the current academic session.
- (v) Applicants are required to upload self-attested copies of Merit/Participation Sports Certificates. Only the highest Merit/Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for granting weightage. The criteria for awarding weightage based on Sports Participation for granting admission to Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes for the academic year 2024-25 are as follows.

2. International Students:

In pursuance of the resolution taken by Standing Committee for Academic Council (SCAC) in its 4th meeting held on 29th May, 2023 and subsequent approvals accorded by the Academic Council and Executive Council in their meetings held on 2nd December, 2023 and 26th December, 2023 respectively :

- (i) 25% supernumerary seat for international students, over and above of sanctioned enrolment for undergraduate programs, has been provisioned.
- (ii) These supernumerary seats for international students will not include international students under exchange programmes or/and through Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between institutions of Government of India and other countries.
- (iii) These 25% seats will be distributed among all departments, schools and centres of study in the University.
- (iv) If seats remain vacant, it shall not be allocated to anyone other than an international student.
- (v) International students in this context shall be defined as the one who shall possess a foreign passport.

(vi) Admission to these 25% supernumerary seats will be governed by guidelines/regulations issued by regulatory bodies relating to infrastructure, faculty and other requirements.

3. PM CARES Children Scheme:

In pursuance of UGC D.O. No. F. 2-39/2022 (CPP-II) dated 30th March, 2022 and resolution taken by Standing Committee for Academic Council (SCAC) in its 4th meeting held on 29th May, 2023 and subsequent approvals accorded by the Academic Council and Executive Council in their meetings held on 2nd December, 2023 and 26th December,2023 respectively, *5% supernumerary seats* in all programs (including special programs and excluding doctoral programs) shall be available for children who have PM CARES Children Scheme, 2021 certificate.

4. Kashmiri Migrants:

As per UGC D.O. letter no. 1-13/2010(CPP-II) dated 20th March 2018, the following will be extended to wards of Kashmiri migrants and Kashmiri pandits / Kashmiri hindu families (non-migrants) living in Kashmir valley for admission in higher educational institutions:

- (a) Relaxation in cut off percentage upto 10% subject to minimum eligibility requirement
- (b) Increase in intake capacity up to 5% program wise
- (c) Reservation of at least one seat in merit quota in technical / professional institutions
- (d) Waiving of domicile requirements

For availing this benefit, the eligible applicants are required to produce certificate issued by competent authority and produce on the date of counselling

5. Defence Quota Applicants:

Five percent (5%) supernumerary seats are sanctioned for widows/wards of the defence personnel killed/disabled in action or during peace time, with following priority:

- 1) Widows/wards of defence personnel/para-military personnel killed in action (Required Certificate: Proof in original)
- 2) Wards of serving defence personnel and ex-servicemen/para-military personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service (Required Certificate: Original disability certificate clearly indicating the disability is attributable to military services.).
- 3) Widows/wards of defence personnel/para-military personnel who died in peace time with death attributable to military service (Required Certificate: Original death certificate clearly indicating the cause of death is attributable to military service).
- 4) Wards of defence personnel/para-military personnel disabled in peace time with disability attributable to military service (Required Certificate: Original disability certificate clearly indicating the disability is attributable to military service).
- 5) Wards of serving defence personnel and ex-servicemen para-military including personnel of police forces who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards: Param Vir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Maha Vir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Vir Chakra, Shaurya Chakra, Sena, Nau Sena, Vayu Sena Medal, Mentioned-in-Dispatches (Required Certificate: Proof of Award in Original).
- 6) Wards of ex-servicemen (Required Certificate: Original ex-servicemen identity card/discharge book/PPO (Pension Payment Order).
- 7) Wives of : (i) defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service. (ii) defence personnel disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to military service. (iii) ex-

servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards. (Required Certificate: Proof of Award in Original).

- 8) Wards of serving defence personnel (Required Certificate: original service identity card and dependent card/certificate issued by competent authority).
- 9) Wives of defence serving personnel (Required Certificate: original service identity card and dependent card/certificate issued by competent authority).

Applicants need to produce/submit the required valid certificate on the date of counselling.

ANTI-RAGGING AFFIDAVITS

According to UGC guidelines and Orders of the Supreme Court of India, students admitted in any program of the University shall submit Anti-Ragging Undertaking in online mode.

- (ii) Category declared in registration form by the applicant shall be considered final while preparation of merit list.
- (iii) Supernumerary quota is not applicable for Integrated B. Ed. and 2 year B.Ed. programs.
- (iv) Admission granted to candidates based on information furnished by applicants during online registration process will be purely provisional.
- (v) Information furnished by applicants will be verified by the Departmental Admission Committee/any other committee as notified by the University from time to time. The original documents should match with submitted documents at the time of physical verification. In case of any aberration or mismatch, candidature of the applicant shall be cancelled/rejected.
- (vi) Non-production of any document (as applicable on case to case basis) within stipulated time shall lead to cancellation of candidature.

OFFICE OF DEAN STUDENTS WELFARE (DSW)

The Office of DSW is spearheaded by Dean Students Welfare and supported by Associate Deans of Student Welfare, Sports Officer, Administrative Wardens, Wardens, Administrative Officer and support staffs. The office performs the overall supervision of hostels, sports and extra-curricular activities, NSS, NCC and scholarships offered by various agencies.

HOSTELS:

The University provides hostel facility to facilitate meritorious students from far off places and heterogeneous back-ground to devote adequate time to their studies and development without worrying about their fooding and lodging, and also facilitate students' interaction among themselves, learn about the culture and diversity of India and became a good citizen firmly believing in the unity and diversity of India. The day-to-day management of hostels are governed by administrative wardens and wardens under the overall supervision of DSW. However, it must be noted that due to infrastructural constrains, seats available in hostel are limited and the university does not guarantee a seat in hostel after admission.

FACILITIES IN HOSTEL:

- Each room is furnished with light, fan, plug points, bed, study table, chair and cupboard.
- Occupancy of hostel is double or triple depending upon the level of program of study.

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HOSTEL ALLOTMENT:

The following criteria are used for hostel allocation (girls and boys)

- a. Merit in entrance examination.
- Hostel Reservation Policy: Other Backward Classes (OBC NCL) 27%, Scheduled Castes (SC) 15%, Scheduled Tribes (ST) 7.5%, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) 10% of the total seats. Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) 5% (horizontal).

PROCTORIAL BOARD

Central University of Jharkhand has a Proctorial Board consisting of Chief Proctor and Members of the Board. The Chairperson of the proctorial board heads the proctor office. The office deals with any emerging matters related to students discipline, crisis management and emergency preparedness, including developing contingency plans, coordinating emergency drills and responding effectively to critical incidents. The office works with stakeholders to promote diversity and equity to create a safe and inclusive campus environment for all.

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

OTHER BACKWARD CLASSES (OBC) CELL

The main objective of OBC Cell is to implement, monitor and evaluate reservation policy in the University and plan measures for ensuring its effective implementation as per Government of India and UGC norms.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CELL

The Equal opportunity cell has been established in the University with the objective to help and empower persons with disabilities, and to enable them to participate fully in the academic, intellectual, social and cultural life of the University on an equal basis. This cell aims to promote diversity and inclusive practices on the campus and provide the disadvantaged groups with adequate opportunities.



LEARNING RESOURCES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

ICT SUPPORTED SMART CLASSROOMS

The classrooms are equipped with interactive multi-functional boards and ICT related infrastructure for teaching and learning.

FEEDBACK SYSTEM

The University has put in place a robust feedback system viz., student feedback, faculty feedback and industry feedback. Students are encouraged to provide feedback about the teaching-learning activities of the University. The feedback is taken into consideration in framing syllabus and to improve teaching-learning process as far as practicable.

MENTORING FACILITY

In day-to-day teaching, faculty members play vital role as mentor for guiding students in their academic and related activities, to groom them as good citizens. Students are mentored by faculty members in areas of examination, classroom learning, job placement, higher studies, research and personal counselling.

STUDENTS SUPPORT SERVICES CELL

The University has Students Support Services Cell (SSS Cell) to counsel students during admission, before going field work and career counselling. Students are assisted in their placement as well, by this cell.

OUTREACH ACTIVITY

The University in fulfilling its social responsibility, runs free remedial coaching classes for NET and GATE. The University is also running "UNNAYAN" Program in which free tuition classes are arranged for students of class I to XII of neighbouring villages. The students of the University extend their cooperation as Volunteer Teachers for them.



STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME

In order to acquaint students with academic and administrative functioning of the University, an Induction Program is organized every year at the beginning of each academic session. The Vice Chancellor and other senior faculty members of the University address the newly admitted students. The students are briefed about program structure, university facilities, policies and procedures regarding examination, attendance, discipline etc. in this induction programme.

EVALUATION AND GRADING PROCESS

The University follows continuous evaluation system in which students' performance in academic activities are assessed through three sessional tests which may include assignments, quiz, minor projects, term paper and book review. In addition to it, term end examinations are conducted. In order to appear in end term exam, students must appear in two sessional exams and secure minimum 75% attendance in each course. The grading system is based on grade points leading to SGPA for semester and CGPA for the program.
