### Action Taken Notice

The following actions have been taken by Central University of Jharkhand based upon 16-point suggestions grounded on feedback collected from the teachers of the university for the Academic Session 2020-2021 as per IQAC Letter Dated 28/09/2021.

1. For upgrading the skills and qualification of teachers, they are allowed to do PhD supported by financial incentives. Further, the university provides all kinds of administrative support to strengthen the research activities of the teachers.
2. The NEP 2020 implementation is under active considerations, awaiting UGC final guidelines. The university is in the process of arranging facilities as per the requirements of NEP 2020.
3. Diverse course action is provided under Choice Based Credit System. Online teaching materials, virtual collaboration, etc. are fully prioritized in in this pandemic phase. The MOOC and NPTEL courses for the teachers are literally encouraged for diverse course options.
4. The existing library is being upgraded to provide online teaching materials to teachers and students.
5. Taking into view the COVID-19 pandemic effect in disrupting the students, the academic calendar is adjusted. In new campus (Cheri Manatu Campus), new room facilities are actively considered to encourage the smooth conduction of classes.
6. Already HEFA loan is being utilized from time to time for both infrastructure and academic purposes.
7. Departments have been provided with funds amounting minimum 10 Lakhs for Lab development. This in turn would help for lab activities of all programmes including PG programmes.
8. The central library has already been allotted fund from book grant of UGC to purchase new books for NEP 2020 purpose. High speed Internet in old campus (Brambe Campus) is already available and utilized. In new campus it is under consideration.
9. The skill development programmes and flexible options are already available under NEP 2020 implementations in the university.
10. Faculties are being provided with the conference grant based upon the policy of the university.
11. Research Innovation Cell is already established. New classrooms/labs are utilized for new academy programs under NEP 2020 as per availability.
12. A big building has been dedicated for science departments in new campus.
13. In new campus, hostels are available with at least 1200 capacity in total. Transport facility is provided with affordable cost. Boundary wall would be constructed in full phased manner and the appropriate road facility will be provided after acquisition of required land for the university.
14. All the schools have been provided offices and some departments have been provided offices. However, offices shall be provided for all departments immediately after availability of required rooms.

15. Maintenance of classroom, hostels, washroom, etc. are in priority for administration from hygiene and safety point of view.
16. Campus security is being strengthened with addition of new security guards. The university tries to addressing the basic needs of employees within available resources.

Based on the feedback collected from the teachers of the university for the **academic session 2020-2021** and the analysis of the feedback, you are requested to take the following actions as quick as possible and communicate this office for further actions.

1. Provides adequate funding and support to faculty members for upgrading their skills and qualifications.
2. There is need for modern educational facilities, including advanced labs, virtual labs, and sufficient classrooms, to enhance learning and support in line with the NEP 2020.
3. The need for better online teaching materials, virtual collaboration, participatory learning, and the availability of diverse course options.
4. Need for establishing new facilities such as an online library.
5. There is need of relocating to a new campus and streamlining admissions that were disrupted by COVID-19.
6. There is need for substantial investment in both infrastructure and academic resources.
7. Allocating funds for the maintenance and enhancement of labs, supporting PG programs, and purchasing the latest science and engineering software.
8. Improving the central library with more books and ensuring high-speed internet throughout the campus are also priorities.
9. The introduction of skill development programs, flexible learning options such as online and hybrid courses.
10. Substantial investment in faculty development are essential for advancing academic excellence.
11. Establishing a research innovation hub, enhancing course structures, and expanding classroom and lab spaces.
12. Dedicated buildings for large departments.
13. Availability of proper hostel facilities and affordable transportation services for faculties and students, constructing an approach road and securing the campus with a boundary wall for improved accessibility and security.
14. Establishing offices in every department to streamline operations and providing financial assistance.
15. Maintaining clean and hygienic washrooms.
16. Strengthening campus security and addressing the basic needs of employees are also essential.
