Relaxation clause:

1. A relaxation of 5% marks may be provided at Graduate and Master's level for the Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled)/Other Backward Class (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during engagement of temporary faculty. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% marks to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
2. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% marks wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
