Sir/Madam,

I would like to mention that the Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad Foundation and MIT School of Government, Pune, have been bringing together students from across the Country in an annual conclave called Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad (Indian Students' Parliament). Fourteen (14) such annual events have already been organized with great success. The **15th Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad** is being organized for three days from February 21st to 23rd, 2026 at MIT World Peace University, Pune. The basic objective of organizing this conclave is to effectively involve the youth in the democratic process of the country. The event is supported by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India Ministry of Higher & Technical Education, Maharashtra, AIU and AICTE. It also gets support/participation from international agencies of repute like the UN, UNESCO, SAARC, Inter-Parliamentary Union, and the Commonwealth.

2. This is a non-partisan and apolitical event, where deliberations are held on issues of contemporary significance. During the last 14 years several eminent personalities have addressed the conclave like Late Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Late Shri. Pranab Mukherjee, Smt. Pratibha Patil, Shri. N. Chandrababu Naidu, Shri. M. Venkaiah Naidu, Shri. L. K. Advani, Shri Shivraj Patil etc. In addition to these, several eminent personalities like, H.E. Aung San Suu Kyi, Ms. Irina Bokova, Smt. Malala Yousafzai, and Ms. Sunita Williams etc., addressed the conclave through pre-recorded video messages.

3. During the 15th Bharatiya Chhatra Sansad, scheduled to be held from February 21 to 23, 2026, deliberations will take place on a number


of important subjects like:

- a. Campus to Cabinet: Can Universities Become the Nurseries of Democracy?
 - b. The Bharat We Don't See: Can Tradition and Transformation Coexist?
 - c. Celebrity Without Credibility: Have We Started Valuing Visibility Over Virtue?
 - d. From Stadium to Statesmanship: What Can Politics Learn from Sports?
4. A number of eminent speakers are expected to speak on the occasion. The details of the programme can be seen on the website www.bharatiyachhatrasansad.org.
5. The Indian Students' Parliament plays a significant role in reshaping the perspective of young individuals and reinforcing their reverence for democracy and its establishments. Likewise, the National Service Scheme (NSS) has the goal of nurturing the character and persona of young students while instilling a sense of national perspective in them. Engaging in the Indian Students' Parliament can strongly contribute to advancing the objectives of the NSS.

The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has developed MY BHARAT Portal: Youth Leadership and Social Engagement Platform which is a digital platform to provide a space for young people to develop their leadership skills, connect with like-minded peers and mentors, and engage with social cause in their communities and beyond, to participate in experiential learning activities to improve their understanding of work in real-life situations. The portal is being developed as a part of Roadmap with the following objectives:
- Provide a platform for young people to develop their leadership skills and engage with social cause.
 - Provide youth an opportunity to avail experiential learning in private and public sector organisations.
 - Foster a sense of community and connection among young people.
 - Provide a platform to allow young people to connect with mentors for counselling.
 - Provide a platform to allow young people to participate and organise events on different themes whether cultural, sports, social causes, competitions etc.
7. In view of this, it is requested that you may kindly, take necessary steps to encourage the participation of NSS volunteers in the forthcoming Indian Students' Parliament in February 2026.
