- Remaining paper in 12 font size.
- The paper should be written in times new roman font style.
- Referencing should be in APA style (7th edition).
- Abstract should be between 200-300 words including 5 key words.
- Manuscript should not exceed more than 7000 words in all.
- The Paper should be sent through e-mail attachment only as a word document to conference.dcfs@cuj.ac.in on or before the last date.
